

About the Institute...



The Institute (IHAR-PIB) was established in 1951 with the headquarters originally located in Warsaw and subsequently moved to Radzików (near Warsaw). Since its onset IHAR-PIB had been subordinated to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development as a major contributor to agricultural R&D network. As a result of socio-economical transformation changes undertaken in 1989 today's IHAR-PIB consists of 6 divisions located at Bonin, Bydgoszcz, Jadwisin, Kraków, Młochów and Poznań; 7 experimental stations and 5 Plant Breeding Companies associated in IHAR-PIB Group. On 16 March 2010 the Plant Breeding and Acclimatization Institute (IHAR) was endowed with a status of National Research Institute (PIB).

The current mission of IHAR-PIB is to develop:

- ⇒ theoretical principles and research methodologies related to germplasm conservation, enhancement and utilization in breeding of field crops,
- ⇒ seed science and seed production,
- ⇒ collection and preservation of plant germplasm resources for breeding and research purposes.
