Aim of the meeting and preliminary program

The meetings of the IOBC-WPRS Working Group "Induced resistance in plants against insects and diseases" are held every 2 years. The aim of these meetings is to foster exchange between all professionals interested in induced resistance in plants to pests and diseases and in its potential use for integrated pest management.

The meeting in 2013 will cover traditional research themes of the Working Group, including components of stress and defence signalling pathways priming for resistance, their interactions, and other aspects of defences induced by biotic or abiotic agents and beneficials.

Particular emphasis will be placed on practical applications of fundamental research and on the research needs to achieve successful exploitation of induced resistance in the field.
