A EuroBlight Workshop will be organised in the city of Arras in France from 3-6 May 2010. The local organisers are: Serge Duvauchelle and Ludovic Dubois from the Ministère de l'Alimentation, l'Agriculture et de la Pèche, S D Q P V, Didier Andrivon and Roselyne Corbière from INRA Rennes, Catherine Chatot from Germicopa SAS and Marie-Pascale Latorse from Bayer CropScience.

Participant arrival is in the afternoon or evening on Monday the 3^{rd} May. There will be 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ days of meeting beginning on Tuesday morning and ending after lunch on Thursday 6^{th} May

The main objective of the Workshop is to present and discuss recent results on integrated control of late blight (*Phytophthora infestans*) and early blight (*Alternaria*). General themes will be:

Topics

- 1. The implementation of the framework directive, particularly the introduction of IPM, which will be compulsory across the EU by 2014.
- 2. EuroBlight in a global perspective.



The specific workshop themes are:

- 1. Host resistance to *P. infestans*
- 2. Pathogen characteristics and population biology and genetics
- 3. Epidemiology, Integrated control and Decision Support Systems
- 4. Fungicides
- 5. Epidemiology and control of *Alternaria spp*.

Participants are asked to offer a contribution on these topics, which will be presented as an oral presentation or a poster. The number of participants is limited to 80. In the event of over-registration, the organising committee will select participants on the basis of an active contribution.

The Proceedings of the Workshop will be published as a PPO-Special Report. Like all previous reports the Proceedings will also be digitally available (www.euroblight.net). Manuscripts can be submitted after the Workshop, but not later than 15 September 2010.



Venue

The Workshop will be held at the **Hotel Mercure** in Arras. The city of **Arras** is located 40 km from Lille and 200 km from Paris (50 Minutes by TGV train from Paris).
