Organisers of ENDURE's second international conference, Integrated Pest Management in Europe - The ENDURE Network of Excellence shares the fruits of four years' research with the crop protection community, met in Berlin this month to put the finishing touches to the event's busy schedule.

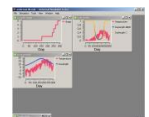
- **ENDURE features in International Innovation**

- **ENDURE: Integrated Pest Management in Europe**

24-25 November 2010: Paris, France. ENDURE will this year host its second major international conference when it stages 'Integrated Pest Management in Europe - The ENDURE Network of Excellence shares the fruits of four years' research with the crop protection community' at the Eurosites George V centre in Paris, France.

- **IOBC Global WG Meetings**

01-05 November 2010: Nairobi, Kenya. The IOBC will be combining two workshops in Nairobi, Kenya, with the 8th IOBC International Workshop on Biological Control and Management of *Chromolaena odorata* and Other Eupatorieae being held in conjunction with the 1st IOBC International Workshop on Biological Control and Management of *Parthenium hysterophorus*.

- **IOBC/WPRS Integrated Protection of Fruit Crops**

07-12 October 2011: Kusadasi, Turkey. The IOBC/WPRS Working Group on Integrated Protection of Fruit Crops will be holding its 8th international conference in the Kusadasi district of Aydin province, Turkey.

- **IOBC/WPRS Workshop on Pome Fruit Diseases**

29 August-2 September 2011: Hasselt, Belgium. The Pome Fruit Diseases sub-group of the IOBC/WPRS Working Group on Integrated Protection of Fruit Crops will hold its 9th international workshop in Hasselt, Belgium.

- **Insect Pathogens and Entomoparasitic Nematodes**

19-23 June 2011: Innsbruck, Austria. The IOBC/WPRS Working Group on Insect Pathogens and Entomoparasitic Nematodes will be focusing on 'Biological Control in IPM Systems' at a three-day meeting in Innsbruck, Austria.

- **Resistance 2011**

05-07 September 2011: Harpenden, Hertfordshire, UK. ENDURE's UK partner, Rothamsted Research, hosts Resistance 2011 in September next year, the sixth major international conference in an ongoing series, which will review new research on the origins, nature, development and prevention of resistance to insecticides, fungicides and herbicides.
